

MOGA BOARD MEETING: MAY 4, 2010

Meeting called to order by Pres. Harold Yates at 8:00 AM in the Greenbrier room at the Oakwood Country Club house.

Members present: Harold Yates, Howard Weiss, Dick Winkelman, Marty Wirt, Steve Crowell, George Rodriguez, Pat Dooley, Bob Greene, Ken Kappes.

Minutes of meeting April 6th were approved as written.

Treasurer's report was approved as submitted; a copy is in the Minute book. New Member Handbooks cost was \$640.00. Membership now stands at 300 members.

Steve Crowell has been appointed new Treasurer and Dick Winkelman will resign as Treasurer to assume duties of Tournament Chairman. A copy of Winkelman's letter has been attached to these minutes.

George reported that the new computer used for entering Thursday MOGA events is up and running. There is a need for a new printer. George will purchase a printer to replace the old one that is malfunctioning at a cost of \$70.00 to \$100.00. There are currently three computers used by Oakwood golfers : (1)for MOGA Sign Up, (2) for Tournament Set up, and (3) for score entry by all.

AGA will soon abandon the current EZLINKS TMS for Golf Net" TMS (Golf Net has acquired EZLINKS.) George Rodriguez and Dick Winkelman will attend a meeting with AGA officials on May 20th to resolve issues regarding this new system.

Homeowner's purchase of the Golf Course was discussed at length. It was reported that a residents' Law Suit has held up the purchase recently approved by the Homeowners. A judgment will be made regarding this Suit by a Judge around May 24th. If the Judge rules in favor of the plaintiffs the purchase will not go thru at this time. June 1, 2010 is the deadline for the purchase agreement. If the Judge rules in Favor of the Homeowners the purchase will proceed as approved.

In the event the purchase is approved there will be a meeting of MOGA board on June 1st to review details of the agreement and to set up a procedure for how MOGA will be involved . If the purchase is not approved there will be no June meeting of MOGA and the next meeting will be held September 7th.

Bob Greene has reported that there will be an article in the next Splash with pictures and reporting of activities of MOGA.

Cottonwood has contacted Harold Yates about MOGA's possible involvement in their Summer Tournament Program which begins on May 18th. Members will be notified and may participate as they desire. A greater degree of cooperation between MOGA and Cottonwood Golf Association is envisioned if the golf course purchase goes through. This will be one of the items reviewed at out June 1st meeting.

Pat Dooley requested a new picture of the Board members for the website including Steve Crowell. Pat will arrange the timing for this photo.
