January continues to bring frost delays which compromise starting times. So that you can plan your golfing day you should be aware of the following rules pertaining to frost delays:

TEE TIMES: Will begin with the first scheduled tee time up to a one hour delay. In the event that the delay is longer than one hour, play will start with the tee time scheduled at the time that the delay is lifted. (**All prior tee times shall be forfeited.**)

SHOTGUN STARTS: 30 MINUTES UP TO ONE HOUR.

The shotgun start will take place and the afternoon shotgun will be set to start at a time that allows the morning group to complete their round. This could delay start up to an hour for the afternoon group.

1-1/2 – 2 HOURS DELAY:

The AM shotgun start will take place when the frost delay is lifted, however, **the morning group shall play only 9 holes.** The afternoon shotgun shall start at the normal time.

The employees will do their best to inform you about the course conditions and delays. They appreciate your patience and cooperation during the delays and hope you understand the reasons why play cannot be permitted when frost is on the course. You might want to consider the possibility of frost when you are making a tee time.
